Call for abstracts

ISGSR2015 aims to bring together engineers, educators, researchers and practitioners to create a better understanding and management of geotechnical safety, reliability and risk.

On behalf of the Scientific Committee, you are cordially invited to submit abstracts of 300 to 500 words for the following seven themes:

1. Geotechnical Risk Management and Risk Communication
2. Variability in Ground Conditions and Site Investigations
3. Reliability and Risk Analysis of Geotechnical Structures
4. Limit-state Design in Geotechnical Engineering
5. Assessment and Management of Natural Hazards
6. Contractual and Legal Issues of Foundations and (Under)Ground Works
7. Case Studies, Monitoring and Observational Method

There is no specific format for the abstract, but it should contain

1. the paper title,
2. the names and affiliations of the authors (incl. contact data for the corresponding author),
3. a brief description of the work to be presented and
4. the conference theme(s) the work addresses.

The official language is English.

The Scientific Committee will review the abstracts to assess their relevance to the symposium, the originality of the work, and its potential contribution to engineering science or practice.
